Electrical, water and other utilities may be severely disrupted or unavailable.</li> <li>Shelter 14 days after radioactive fallout. It is critical to do so.</li> <li>You "may" need to briefly leave shelters to locate supplies. This should be minimal time.</li> <li>Emergency Management will assess radiation levels and advise when sheltering can discontinue.</li> </ul>
	STAY TUNED	<ul> <li>1. Listen to local AM/FM radio stations for official information.</li> <li>2. Cell phone, television, radio and internet services will be severely disrupted or unavailable.</li> <li>3. Small portable walkietalkies may give you communication with nearby shelters.</li> <li>Local AM/FM broadcasts are survivable and useful in advising the public.</li> <li>Other technologies may be damaged by impact.</li> <li>Some radio services are available and may be useful in keeping people informed or in contact with others.</li> </ul>
